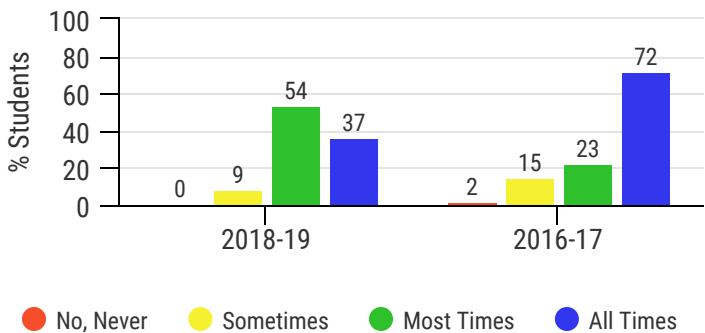
## Ralph Dunlap Elementary

### School Engagement

- 84% say the adults at school care about them most or all of the time (88%)
- 82% feel they hear when they do a good job from adults at school (76%)
- 76% feel students are treated fairly by teachers all or most of the time (89%)

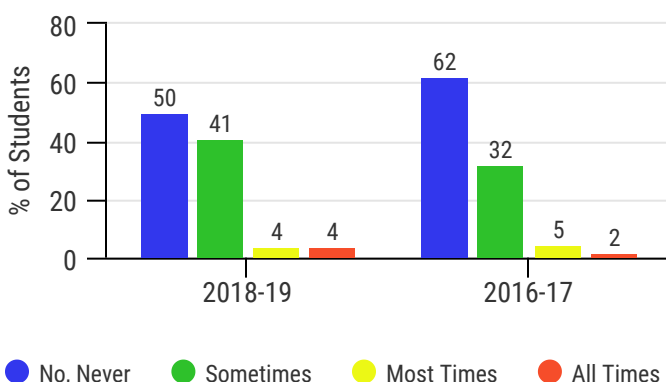
### Do Students Feel Safe at School?



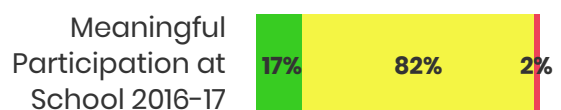
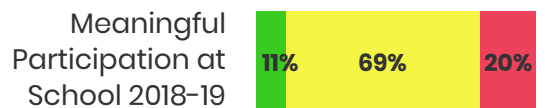
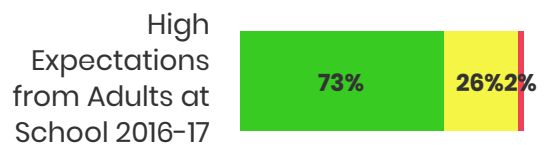
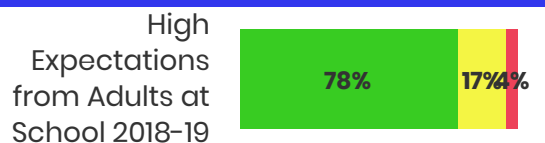
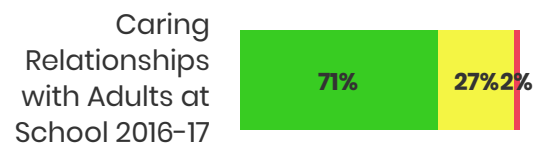
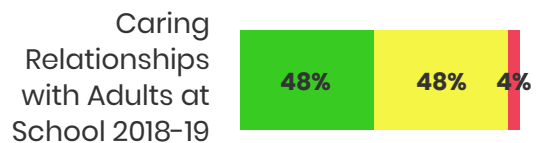
### Engaged Living & Problem Solving

- 84% feel positive good things will happen to them at school most or all of the time
- 52% wake up excited to go to school most or all of the time
- 73% find someone to talk to for help most or all of the time

### Belief in Self and Others

- 94% say when they get a bad grade, they try even harder next time (97%)
- 93% try to work out their problems most or all of the time
- 74% try to understand what other people are going through

### Bullying & Alcohol/Drug/Tobacco Use

- 88% report that adults at school do NOT allow bullying (88%)
- 85% report NEVER having tried drugs or alcohol (83%)
- 2% claim to have tried any type of cigarette (2%)
