Outdoor Science Camp Packing List

Old clothes make the best camp clothes - pack stuff that is sturdy and you don't mind if they get dirty. You don't need to buy anything new for camp. **Remember to label everything with your child's first and last name - items can get lost easily.**

If your child's school is coming during the winter months, please send **EXTRA warm clothes/rain gear.**

Clothes

- Socks & underwear (4 pair)
- T-Shirt (2)
- Long pants (4) (mandatory for hikes & most activities)
- Sweatshirts/sweater
- Jacket/Rain gear (we hike in the rain so be prepared)
- 1 pair of shorts/Pajamas
- 2 A pair of sturdy, close-toed shoes
- Gloves (for warmth)
- 8-10 MASK (MANDATORY)**

Personal Items

- Water bottle (2-3 for a total of at least 36oz.)
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Camera (disposable)
- Stationery and paper
- Reading book
- Money (for trading post)
- Flashlight - Backpack for hiking at night

Toiletries

- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Soap (and soap dish)
- Shampoo/conditioner
- Hairbrush
- Washcloth & Towel
- Anti-Perspirant/Deodorant
- Tote bag to carry toiletries
- Chapstick & body lotion
- Extra glasses or contacts if needed
- Dirty clothes bag

Other Items

- Ear Plugs
- Swimsuit (one piece – for shower)
- Pre-addressed, stamped envelopes or postcards
- Rain jacket
- Hat (for sun and warmth)
- Small backpack or day pack
